Re: Cameron Walk Road Closure Information – Starting August 2026

We are writing to inform you about a planned closure of Cameron Walk and the junction with Gainsborough Square. The closure is necessary in order to carry out essential drainage works at the Cameron Walk housing development site, being delivered by Stepnell Limited.

We appreciate this will cause significant disruption for residents in the area, but Stepnell have explored all options and worked closely with Wessex Water; this is the only viable route for the new drainage.

To minimise the impact, the works will be carried out in the three phases on the next page.

1	Cameron Walk - full road closure to relocate site cabins onto the footpath and eastbound carriageway. The road will be re-opened for 2-way traffic.	3 days from 17 th to 19 th August 2026	Traffic Management will be in place, road will be closed Traffic management will be installed to Branwyn Close for bus diversions.
Approx 2-week gap after cabin relocation before full Cameron Walk closure			
2	Stage 1 - Full Cameron Walk road closure and junction with Gainsborough Square for S104 off-site drainage connections to public sewer	Approx 3.5 weeks from 4 th Sep-2026 to 5 th -Oct-2026	Traffic diversions in place. See TravelWEST website for updates on bus routes, bus stops will display notices Traffic management will be installed to Branwyn Close for bus diversions.
3	Stage 2 - Full Cameron Walk road closure – Gainsborough Square junction reopened	Approx 3.5 weeks from 5 th -Oct-2026 to 2 nd -Nov-2026	Off-site Drainage connection works continued Traffic management will be installed to Branwyn Close for bus diversions.

Unfortunately some disruption to bus routes are unavoidable. First Bus and Bristol City Council's Transport Team are working together and putting the necessary measures in place to minimise disruption. The road closures will be monitored by the Traffic Management Company and if you have any questions, please contact Traffic@bristol.gov.uk.
